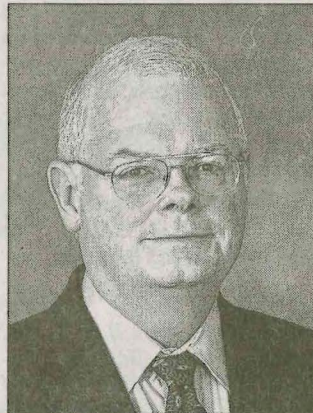

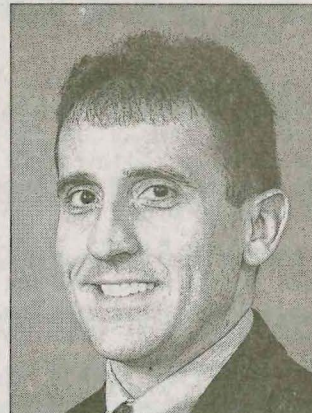
Save the Date

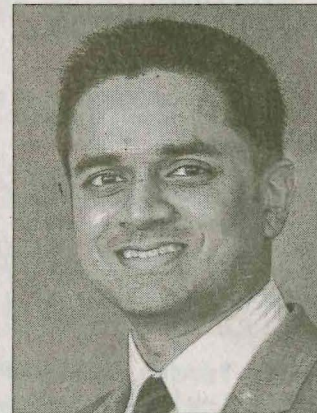
